- Current on Mortgage and Property Taxes
- Home Built before 1978
- Household Income below 80% (unless Ohio Department of Health has orders to remove lead)

**Cannot be on a Land Contract or Life Estate*

The Facts About Lead

- ❑ Lead can affect children’s brains and developing nervous systems, causing reduced IQ, learning disabilities, and behavioral problems. Lead is also harmful to adults.
- ❑ Lead dust is the most common way people are exposed to lead. People can also get lead in their bodies from lead in soil or paint chips. Lead dust is often invisible.
- ❑ Lead-based paint was used in more than 38 million homes until it was banned for residential use in 1978
- ❑ DIY Projects that disturb painted surfaces can create dust and endanger you and your family. Don’t let this happen to you!
