The **Williams County Board of Commissioners** intends to apply to the Ohio Department of Development: Office of Community Development (OCD) for federal grant funding. Grant funding is available through the Federal Department of Housing and Urban Development’s (HUD) Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG), which the OCD administers.

On 1/19/2023, the first out of two mandatory public hearings for the federal CDBG Program, Program Year 2023 were conducted. The purpose of “Public Hearing #1” was to inform citizens and community officials about potential grant funding sources within that grant program for program year 2023.
