

## NOTICE OF SECOND PUBLIC HEARING

The **Henry County Board of Commissioners** intends to apply to the Ohio Department of Development: Office of Community Development (OCD) for federal grant funding. Grant funding is available through the Federal Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG), which the OCD administers.

On 1/31/2023, the first out of two mandatory public hearings for the federal CDBG Program, Program Year 2023 were conducted. The purpose of "Public Hearing #1" was to inform citizens and community officials about potential grant funding sources within that grant program for program year 2023.

Public Hearing #2 will be held on **Tuesday, May 2, 2023 @ 9:30 am** at the **Henry County Commissioners Office** at 1853 Oakwood Ave, Napoleon, OH 43545. The purpose of this public hearing is to provide the public with an opportunity to review and comment on the following proposed projects prior to submission for funding from the federal CDBG Program, Program Year 2023:

\*CDBG funding request limits are determined by the Ohio Department of Development: Office of Community Development. If/when a project is applied for through the federal CDBG Program, the amount of the final grant funding request is determined by the Henry County Board of Commissioners.

These proposed projects were created based on a combination of public input, needs assessments performed by local officials and private civil engineering firms, and project solicitation performed by the Maumee Valley Planning Organization on behalf of the Henry County Board of Commissioners.

Community Officials and Project Managers are encouraged to attend this public hearing so that they can elaborate on project details as the Commissioners need them to.
